To Add To A Project To A Studio.

- 1. Go to the project you want to add to the studio.
- 2. Save the file with a *descriptive* name.
- 3. Click the SHARE button in the upper right corner.
- 4. This will take you to a screen that lets you enter:
 - Instructions: Tell people how to use your project (such as which keys to press).
 - Notes and Credits: How did you make the project? Did you use ideas, scripts, or artwork from other people? Thank them here.
 - **Project Tags**: Choose from the ones listed or add some yourself. These are search terms someone might use to find your project.
 - **Comments:** You can "Turn off commenting" so others can not post their comments about your project.
 - **Draft:** If it is a draft of a project you can indicate that by clicking the small box next to the word DRAFT
- 5. Open a new tab in your Web Browser
- 6. Enter the address of the Studio where you want to add your project. (Note: You can also search by name of the user or the studio name.) The URL starts the same but has a different number like below:

- 7. Click the Add Projects button
- 8. From the list of projects that will pop up at the bottom, click on the ones you want to add to the studio.
